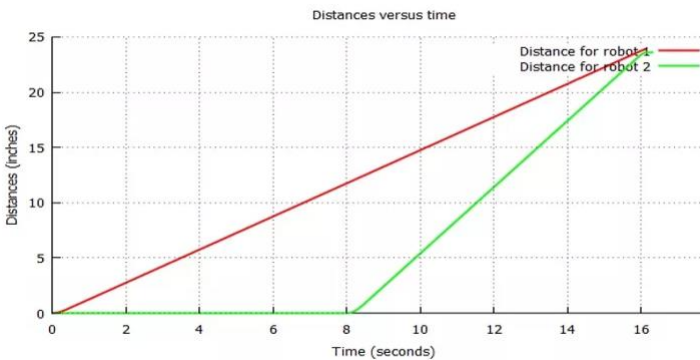
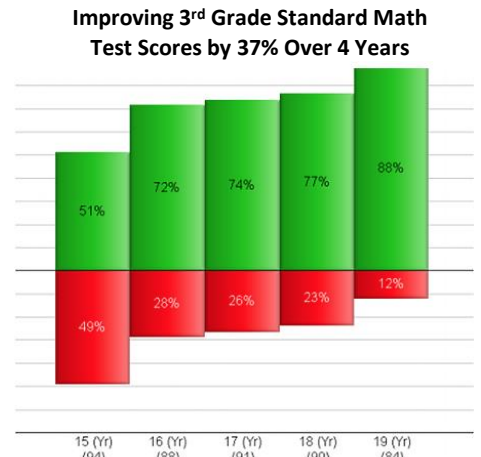




Free One-Day Workshop on Integrating Robotics and Arduino into K-12 CS and STEAM Education
